## BYLAW NO. 327

A Bylaw of the Town of Cabri to provide for the control and regulation of firearms and firecrackers.

The Council of the Town of Cabri enact as follows:

- 1. In this Bylaw the expression "firecrackers" shall be construed as meaning any article which creates a loud and offensive noise when it is ignited, set off or exploded, provided however, the expression "firearms" shall not include any bullets, or shells, used in connection with firearms.
- No person, merchant, dealer, or agent shall sell firecrackers, to any person whether on a wholesale or retail basis, within the Town of Cabri.
- 3. No person shall fire or discharge any gun, airgun, catapult, fowling piece, or any other form of firearm within the Town of Cabri, except as hereinafter provided.
- 4. No person shall light, ignite, set off, or throw any firecracker squib, serpent, or other noisy, offensive, or dangerous substance within the Town of Cabri except as hereinafter provided.
- 5. Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore provided, the Council may by resolution authorize any person to use firearms or firecrackers, within a specified portion of the Town, for a specified period of time.
- 6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Cabri.
- 7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing hereof.
